


## #2065QB Just Trucks Quilt Quiet Book - 15" x 8"

### MATERIALS NEEDED:

#2065 Just Trucks Quilt pattern by Spring Creek NeedleArt  
 1/2 yd. dark blue print (front & back covers, page borders)  
 1/3 yd. yellow print (page borders)  
 3/4 yd. medium blue print (backgrounds)  
 3/4 yd. white flannel (page linings, wash & dry before using)  
 fabric scraps for trucks - see pattern  
 fusible web (optional, letters on front cover)  
 14 - 1/4" grommets/eyelets  
 2 - 1 1/2" or 2" loose leaf binder rings  
 (found at office supply stores)



### CUT THE FOLLOWING (see the next page for layout):

**medium blue print fabric** - Cut 6 1 1/2" strips across the width of the fabric, then cut the background rectangles as indicated on the next page.

**dark blue print fabric** - Cut one 8 1/2" strip across the width of the fabric, then cut the two covers. Cut some of the side borders (1 1/2" wide) from the remainder of this strip. Cut five 1 1/2" strips across the width of the fabric. Cut the remaining side borders and top and bottom borders from these strips.

**yellow print fabric** - Cut 1 1/2" strips across the width of the fabric; then cut the border strips as indicated.

**flannel** - Cut three 8 1/2" strips across the width of the fabric. Then cut the following widths: 12 1/2", 13", 13 1/2", 14", 14 1/2", 15" and 15 1/2".

### CONSTRUCTION

Refer to the Just Trucks Quilt pattern and appliqué one truck in the center of each of the twelve rectangles (see next page for layout). You must add seam allowance for appliqué. How much depends on your choice of appliqué method and personal preference.

**Stitch the borders:** Using 1/4" seam allowance, stitch the top and bottom borders to each of the rectangles. Press the seams toward the border. Stitch the side borders (8 1/2" long) to each of the rectangles. Press the seams toward the borders. See next page for the layout.

**Front cover:** Appliqué the letters to the dark blue 12 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle.



**Pair up the pages:** Make sure to match the tops of the same size rectangles.

**Layer and stitch the pairs together:** Stack each pair and the same size flannel rectangle in the following order:


- flannel rectangle (cut a 1/2" triangle off of each corner)
- truck rectangle *face up*
- truck rectangle or cover *face down*

Using 1/4" seam allowance, stitch the three layers together. Leave about 3" open for turning. Clip the corners. Turn inside out. Square up corners. Press the edges. Blind stitch the opening closed.


**Grommets/eyelets:** Mark the **centers** 1/2" from the left edge and 1 1/2" from the top or bottom edge. A template is provided on the last page of these instructions. Follow the instructions with the grommets/eyelets.



Stitch the top & bottom borders, then the side borders.




Stitch around, clip corners, turn inside out, and stitch the opening closed.



**Front Cover** (dark blue) - cut 1 - 12 1/2" x 8 1/2"

#### Racing Truck

background (medium blue) - cut 1 - 10 1/2" x 6 1/2"

side borders (dark blue) - cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"

top & bottom borders (dark blue) - cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 10 1/2"




#### SUV & Food Truck

backgrounds (medium blue) - cut 2 - 11" x 6 1/2"

side borders (yellow) - cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"

top & bottom borders (yellow) - cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 11"





#### Pickup & Delivery Trucks

backgrounds (medium blue) - cut 2 - 11 1/2" x 6 1/2"

side borders (dark blue) - cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"

top & bottom borders (dark blue) - cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 11 1/2"





#### Garbage & Dump Trucks

backgrounds (medium blue) - cut 2 - 12" x 6 1/2"

side borders (yellow) - cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"

top & bottom borders (yellow) - cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 12"





#### Ambulance & Cement Truck

backgrounds (medium blue) - cut 2 - 12 1/2" x 6 1/2"

side borders (dark blue) - cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"

top & bottom borders (dark blue) - cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 12 1/2"




#### Flatbed & Tanker Trucks

backgrounds (medium blue) - cut 2 - 13" x 6 1/2"

side borders (yellow) - cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"

top & bottom borders (yellow) - cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 13"



#### Big Rig

background (medium blue) - cut 1 - 13 1/2" x 6 1/2"

side borders (dark blue) - cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"

top & bottom borders (dark blue) - cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 13 1/2"

**Back Cover** (dark blue) - cut 1 - 15 1/2" x 8 1/2"

### Suggestions:

Have fun making up names and slogans for the signs on the trucks. Include a family name or child's name to personalize.

Write or embroider the name of the truck on the background or the border.


Personalize the covers with the name(s) of the child(ren).

Add embellishments: small bows, buttons, beads, lace or trim, etc.

Lengths of cord or leather can be used instead the binder rings. Knot the ends.

Machine-made eyelet can be used in place of the metal grommets/eyelets.

### Front Cover

Prepare templates for the letters.  
Following the instructions with the fusible web, iron the fusible web on the back of the fabric. Trace around the letters on the paper backing of the fusible web. Cut out.  
Fuse the letters to the front cover. Zigzag or embroider around edges.

**Template for Grommet Placement**  
Cut out the rectangle. Use a 1/4" hole punch to make the two holes.  
Match the rectangle with the left side border (or left edge) of each page. Mark the two holes.  
Follow the directions given with the grommets.
